For convenient positioning. It serves as part rest to elevate parts above tabletop.

- Use the Channel Block and Rest Button when a flat, continuous support surface is required directly over the 40mm table slots.
- After mounting the Channel Block, insert the Rest Button into the center hole of the Channel Block to create a continuous work surface.
- "Fill" any of the 40mm slots in the tabletop whenever stock, or a clamp, needs to be placed directly over a slot.
- Can be used in combination with the Channel Block to "fill" any of the 40mm slots in the tabletop, creating a solid surface that is perfectly level with the tabletop.

The very practical, modular design of the BuildPro® Table makes it easy to set-up and tear down for job at hand, big or small. Save time and money by holding, positioning and locating quickly and easily with a wide variety of BuildPro® clamps and accessories.

All BuildPro® Tables have 16mm thick steel plate with 16mm holes in a 50mm grid pattern. All tables, except BuildPro® MAX, have 40mm slots between plates.

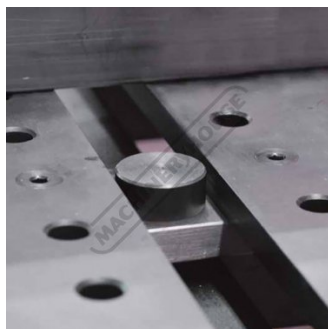

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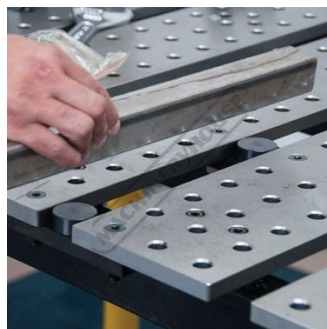
Specific Features
